ALL RIDERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A HELMET – IF YOU DO NOT BRING A HELMET YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO RIDE.

This is a working ranch so there are no dogs allowed. Please leave your dogs at home.

- Hwy 2 (exit 450) West on hwy 53
- Travel 3.8 km to hwy 795 (Usona Road)
- Turn north on hwy 795
- Go 9 km north (road will do a couple curves) to township road 435
- Turn west onto township road 435
- Go 2.8 km west
- At the first crossroad there is a sign “Dead end road”, yes you are on the correct road keep going west
- MSW Farms is on the south side of the road at the end of the road
