Information Sheet

We are excited to have the opportunity to hold the second Badlands Boulder Dash ride, which is a 2 day ride this year! With even more trail and exciting new landscape and scenery, you won't want to miss this ride!

Ride Camp will be open at noon on Friday May 30.

Registration to begin at 2 PM.

Vet ins will be as soon as our vets arrive.

Ride meeting will be around 8PM. We will announce ride times at this time.

Intro ride- 10 miles (May 31 and June 1) the intro trail will be different each day!

Novice ride- 25 miles (May 31 and June 1)

Intermediate ride- 30 miles (May 31 and June 1)

Open ride- 60 miles (May 31 only)

Directions;

From Donalda, Alberta

Intersection of HWY 53 and HWY 850

Travel East on HWY 53 for 9.8 KM,

Turn North (left) on Range RD 17-5 for 5.2 KM,

Turn East (right) into the landowners yard, please drive slowly through the yard.

Follow the signs to ride camp!

All riders must be AEF members prior to the ride for insurance purposes. Helmets are mandatory whenever mounted, even in ride camp.

Please note;

This is private property, please treat it with respect. No smoking on the trail. Please take any garbage out with you and if you see any on the trail please pick it up.

Dogs are allowed in camp, but must remain on a leash at all times.

Porta-Potties and water for the horses will be on site. However there will not be any potable drinking water, so please bring your own drinking water.

Manure can be spread, however any loose hay or straw, please pack it out with you.

Please pack out all your garbage at the end of the weekend.

Please bring a dish for a potluck to be had on the Saturday evening, May 31st. Ribbons and placings to follow the potluck. Please bring your own plates and utensils.

Sunday June 1st will be barebones with no ribbons, placings to be announced as soon as vetting is done and results are in.
