This is a 1 day ride with **Novice**, **Intermediate** and **Open** divisions and an **Introductory Ride**. Friday's registration will begin at 3 pm with initial vet-in beginning at 4 pm. You must arrive on Friday to be vetted in for Saturday's Ride.

The **Introductory Ride** includes a Friday night vetting tutorial. On Saturday, riders can complete the introductory loop at their own pace, as many times as they would like, with ride mentors on hand and Pulse and Respiration (P&R) checks available after each round.

Please send in your entry forms by Monday, July 21.

Most of this ride will be on ranch property with some gravel road. Barefoot Friendly. Cell phone access is available throughout the ride.

All participants must be AEF members prior to the ride for insurance purposes. Please have this done before you arrive and bring proof of membership with you. It is the rider's responsibility to be familiar with the rules.
